



TREKKING TOUR in PUTAO (05 days / 04 nights – Putao Trekking House)

Yangon - Putao - Yangon

Day 01

YANGON - PUTAO

We will bring you to the airport in Yangon. You will fly with Air Bagan via Mandalay and Myitkyina to Putao.

Located at the foot of the Himalayas, Putao is the northernmost town in Myanmar. Putao lies in a flat valley, famous as a jumping-off point for trekkers who want to explore the region's deep forests, wildlife sanctuaries and snow-capped mountains. The richness in biodiversity of this region presents unparalleled opportunities in the field of zoology, botany, forestry and ecology. It serves as the starting point for trekking and hiking tours through local villages, home to tribes including the Lisu and Rawang. In the surrounding mountains many rare species of animals can be found - making this area particularly attractive to bird watchers. This region of the Himalayas is one of the last areas of subtropical rain forests.



Putao is also the starting point for treks to the Mt. Hkakaborazi, with an elevation of 5.881 m (19.295 ft) the highest mountain in Southeast Asia.

Our resident representative will wait for you at the airport in Putao. You will drive together to the Putao Trekking House.

The Putao Trekking House is managed by an experienced group of travel industry professionals who have journeyed the region intensively by themselves. The Putao Trekking House offers exclusive trekking programs into this tribal land of dense forests and snow-capped mountains, which to this day remain completely cut off from the modern world.

After a brief fresh up we shall walk to the near by local restaurant. In the afternoon we will take a walk to a near by Majaw Lisu village, about two hours through the paddy field. This village is beautiful, having the backdrop of Mt. Slimatdin with blazing snow over the horizon during sunset. Dinner will be taken at a local restaurant or at your hotel. We shall have a group meeting, introducing among the group members with local staff and briefing about the trek prior to dinner.

Day 02

PUTAO

After the breakfast we will we trek to the Nam Htu Koo Lisu Village, which is located about 20 km west of Putao. First we walk through cultivation fields passing some small villages and farm land. After about one hour walking on the flat land we are immediately in the wilderness with lush tropical evergreen forests. After about three hours of trekking through the terrain up hill we reach the shoulder of the Nam Htu Khoo Mountain Range (approximately 2.300 ft, 700 m) from where the road descends all the way. Here, we see the valley filled with cultivation

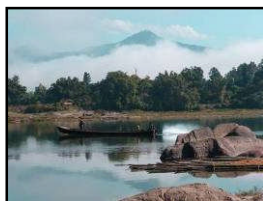
land. Far west we will see the Lancrumadin Mountain (11.530 ft, 3.495 m), close to the Indian border. We have packed lunch and continue to trek another hour through the farm to the village. We check in at our designated home and walk to the creek for a fresh up. This creek is usually busy during the late afternoon when locals on their return home from the work on the fields use it for washing; thus we shall have a great opportunity for social interaction with locals. Dinner will served by a local chef.

Day 03

PUTAO



After the breakfast we will visit the village for social and cultural interaction.

We will say good bye to the village and walk about 45 minutes through the fields along the Nam Htu Koo creek, crossing the creek a couple of time. Once we get in to the wilderness the terrain descends to approximately 2.295 ft, 700 m. We trek about two hours through a

quite jungle filled with bamboo grove. The trek then gradually descends through farm land from where we can enjoy a spectacular view of the Putao plain with the snake like crawling Mula creek.

After about two hours of easy trekking we finally arrive at the Mulashidi village. Here we have our lunch and relax by the Mula creek. Later we will return back to Putao by jeep. We shall have dinner at a local restaurant.

Day 04

After an early breakfast we will visit the attractive Putao market which often fills with local tribes, such as the Rawan, Lisu, Kachin etc.

We will also enjoy a further excursion by jeep to Machanbaw (20 km, approximately one hour). Machanbaw is a small administrative town with a beautiful set up and some colonial buildings. We arrive at Naungkan village and walk over a small suspension bridge that spans across the Malikha River to Machanbaw. The excursions in town include a visit to a small market and a break at the Malikha River bank. We enjoy our dinner at a local restaurant in Putao.

- All other services not mentioned in inclusions

GENERAL REMARKS:

- The domestic flights to/from Putao are operating on Tuesdays and Fridays only!
- Minimum age for all rafting and trekking expeditions is 12 years.
- There is a hotel surcharge and some extra compulsory services for reservations in special times (New Year, Christmas, etc.). Any change of the itinerary or number of participants is subject to price change.
- For any modification of date or itinerary the prices can be revised.
- Usually the room will be available only from 14:00 on the arrival date to 12:00 on the departure date. Depending on the hotels policy, the supplement will be added for early check-in or late check-out.
- The cost of the air tickets are subject to change without prior notice by the airlines.
